WIRRAL DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

WIRRAL (THE WARRENS) MODIFICATION ORDER NO. 1 2009

The above Order made on 20 March 2009, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding to them a footpath which runs in a generally north westerly direction through an area of land known as The Warrens for a length of 167.8 metres or thereabouts with a width throughout of 2 metres starting at a point marked A on Thingwall Road East at The Warrens entrance (grid reference 275852) and terminating at a point marked D where it joins the permissive path within Arrowe Park (grid reference 274854).

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at the Seacombe One Stop Shop, Town Hall, Brighton Street, Wallasey, Wirral between the hours of 9.00 am and 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday each week. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at the price of £5.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the Director of Law, HR and Asset Management (quoting reference JRJ/TS/W1/1/27) not later than 11 May 2009 stating the grounds upon which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, Wirral Borough Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
