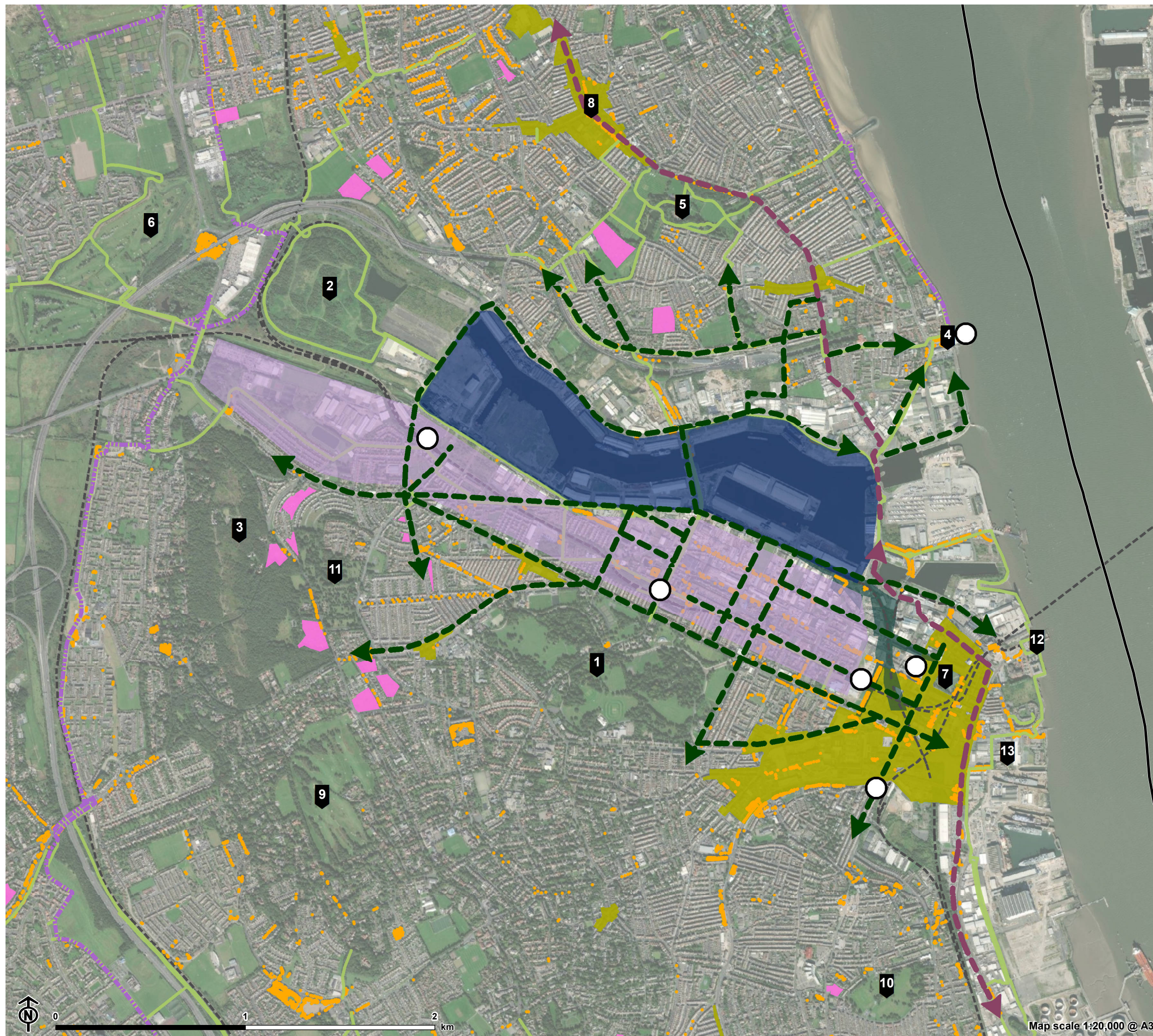


Figure 4.4 Opportunities for urban greening and active neighbourhoods in Birkenhead
