DECISION TO MAKE A NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR HOYLAKE

Wirral Council on 19 December 2016 resolved to legally 'make' the Neighbourhood Development Plan prepared by the Hoylake Neighbourhood Planning Forum.

The effect of this resolution is to make the Neighbourhood Development Plan part of the statutory Development Plan for Hoylake.

Decisions on whether or not to grant planning permission in Hoylake will now need to be made in accordance with the Neighbourhood Development Plan unless material considerations indicate otherwise.

The Council has taken this decision because the Neighbourhood Development Plan has been prepared by a qualifying body in consultation with the local community; an independent examination has found that the Plan has met the basic conditions set out in Schedule 4B of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended); because more than half those voting in the local referendum held on 1 December 2016 voted in favour of using the Plan to decide planning applications in Hoylake; and the Plan is not considered to breach or otherwise be incompatible with any EU obligation or any of the convention rights (within the meaning of the Human Rights Act 1998).
