SPD1 - Designing For Development By Mobile Phone Operators**

On 30 October 2006 Wirral Borough Council resolved to formally adopt the Supplementary Planning Document - SPD1 - Designing For Development By Mobile Phone Operators.

Any person who feels aggrieved by the Supplementary Planning Document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event no later than three months after the date on which the Supplementary Planning Document was adopted.

A copy of the adopted Supplementary Planning Document, the Report of Consultation, the Sustainability Appraisal/Environmental Report and the adoption statement for the purposes of the Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations are available for public inspection free of charge at the public counter of the Technical Services Department, at the Cheshire Lines Building in Canning Street, Birkenhead, Monday to Friday between 9.00 and 17.00 hours, and at public libraries during normal opening hours.
