

THE DUNGEON (WIRRAL) TREE PRESERVATION (REVOCATION)

ORDER, 1953.

WHEREAS it appears to us the County Council of the Administrative County of Chester (hereinafter called "the Council") that by reason of the groups of trees referred to in the First Schedule to The Dungeon (Wirral) Tree Preservation Order, 1949, being now vested in the Wirral Urban District Council with a view to the preservation thereof it is no longer expedient that such groups of trees should be preserved by means of such Order.

3. THIS ORDER may be cited as The Dungeon (Wirral) Tree Preservation (Revocation) Order, 1953, and shall take effect from the date on which it is confirmed by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

"1. The Order entitled The Dungeon (Wirral) Tree Preservation Order, 1949 (hereinafter called "the 1949 Order") which was made by the Council on the 11th day of February 1949 and confirmed by the Minister of Town and Country Planning on the 28th day of June, 1949, is hereby revoked.

2. The provisions of subsection (2) of Section 38 of the Interpretation Act, 1939, shall apply to the revocation by this Order of the 1949 Order as it applies to the repeal by an Act of Parliament of any other enactment."
