WHEREAS the Urban District Council of Wirral (hereinafter called "the Council") act on behalf of the Local Planning Authority as respects the land in the urban district more particularly described in the First Schedule hereto

AND WHEREAS the Council are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the class specified in the Second Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the said land unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf

- THE COUNCIL HEREBY DIRECT in pursuance of Article 4 of the Town & Country Planning General Development Order 1963 that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the development specified in the Second Schedule hereto on the land described in the First Schedule hereto
- THIS DIRECTION may be cited as "The Wirral Urban District (Heswall and Thurstaston) Direction 1965" and shall come into force on the date on which notice thereof is served on the occupiers of the land or if there are no occupiers on the owners of the land

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

All those pieces or parcels of land comprising 870 acres or thereabouts situated within the parishes of Heswall and Thurstaston in the urban district of Wirral in the County of Chester which are delineated on the plan annexed hereto and thereon surrounded by a red line excepting the land coloured blue on the said plan

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

The development described in Paragraph 1 of Class VI of Part I of the First Schedule to the Town & Country Planning General Development Order 1963
