<ol> <li>NOTES:</li> <li>The applicant shall include a scale plan 1:1250 or 1:2500 showing the location of the proposed event and the roads in the vicinity.</li> <li>In the case of a TTRO where traffic is to be diverted, the applicant shall employ a competent Traffic Management Engineer to design a suitable diversion route &amp; sign schedule, to be submitted with this application for approval. A TTRO will not be authorised unless an acceptable signing scheme has been submitted.</li> <li>All TTRO's and diversion routes shall be signed, guarded &amp; lit in accordance with Chapter 8 of The Traffic Signs Manual.</li> <li>The Highway Authority may require the applicant to carry out an informal notification of their proposals to residents/businesses in the area of the TTRO.</li> <li>TTRO's affecting several sites may be considered as one application for charging purposes (subject to prior agreement with the Highway Authority).</li> <li>Applicants should allow a minimum of 8 - 12 weeks for the processing of a TTRO in normal circumstances.</li> </ol>
