Sample of courses offered

- Babies and Toddlers: Developing, Learning and Playing (6 hrs including breaks) (understanding the developmental needs of the 0-2s and the impact on planning and provision)
- Accept, Respect and Tolerate? (6 hrs including breaks) (Reflecting on inclusion and inclusive practice)
- Feel, Move, Share (3 hours including break) (Supporting Young Children to represent their feelings through the language of creative movement to support and develop early literacy skills, creative movement and imagination skills, and provide awareness for developing self-regulation and pro-social behaviour). NB: This course is delivered with a co-trainer, Ruth Jones, who is a contemporary dance artist specialising in sited, parade and mass participation dance work)
- Understanding and supporting the characteristics of effective teaching and learning (3 hours including break) (how best to support children's learning)

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- Supporting boys' early literacy skills (6 hrs including breaks) (Exploring the range of skills and understanding that support early literacy skills and some of the barriers that might be faced by boys, and ways to develop and support them)
- Learning to behave (6 hrs including breaks) (understanding the range of developmental skills and understanding required to respond to rules and how best to support children in this)
- Emotional Well-Being for managers (3 hours including break) (Support for managers to explore emotional wellbeing for personal development and leadership skills)
