- 1. The applicant shall include a scale plan 1:1250 or 1:2500 showing the location of the proposed works and the roads in the vicinity.
- 2. In the case of a TTRO where traffic is to be diverted, the applicant shall employ a competent Traffic Management Engineer to design a suitable diversion route & sign schedule, to be submitted with this application for approval. A TTRO will not be authorised unless an acceptable signing scheme has been submitted.
- 3. All roadworks and diversion routes shall be signed, guarded & lit in accordance with Chapter 8 of The Traffic Signs Manual.
- 4. The applicant will be required to carry out appropriate informal notification of their proposals to residents/businesses in the area of the TTRO and provide details to the Highway Authority.
- 5. TTRO's affecting several sites may be considered as one application for charging purposes (subject to prior agreement with the Highway Authority).
- 6. Applicants should allow 12 weeks for the processing of a TTRO.
- 7. Untill you receive confirmation, you must not assume that the closure dates you have requested have been approved.
