Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for Wirral Council were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

Past flood risk

Past Floods:

13th August 2012

15th August 2012

29th August 2012

24th September 2012

5th December 2013

August & September 2015

Understanding of flood risk has increased both with respect to areas at risk and multiple sources of risk. Increased knowledge has informed both the local flood risk management strategy (LFRMS) and S19¹ Action Plans and influenced priorities in the investment programme.

Future flood risk

No new information relating to improved understanding of future flood risk, impact of climate change or through long term development has been created or received by Wirral Council as lead local flood authority (LLFA).

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

No FRAs have been identified within the Wirral Council lead local flood authority (LLFA) area for the purposes of the Flood Risk Regulations (2009) second planning cycle.

Other changes

There are no other important changes arising since the publication of the PFRA to be considered which impact on the assessment of flood risk as part of this review
