On 30 October 2006 Wirral Borough Council resolved to formally adopt the Supplementary Planning Document - SPD3 - Hot Food Takeaways, Restaurants, Cafes And Drinking Establishments.

Any person who feels aggrieved by the Supplementary Planning Document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event no later than three months after the date on which the Supplementary Planning Document was adopted.

A copy of the adopted Supplementary Planning Document, the Report of Consultation and the Sustainability Appraisal Report are available for public inspection free of charge at the public counter of the Technical Services Department, at the Cheshire Lines Building in Canning Street, Birkenhead, Monday to Friday between 9.00 and 17.00 hours, and at public libraries during normal opening hours.
