Wirral's Sufficiency Strategy:

Wirral's Plan for providing the Right Support and Accommodation at the Right Time for Children in Care and Care Leavers

When children come into care, the local authority and its partners become their corporate parent. Corporate Parents have a responsibility to make sure that all children and young people are provided with suitable accommodation; accommodation that protects and promotes their emotional and physical wellbeing and supports them to reach their full potential.

Wirral's Children looked after sufficiency strategy describes how the local authority and its partners will work together to provide the best environments for children in care and care leavers.

The strategy explains that whenever possible, families will be supported so they can stay together and that when this is not possible, children and young people will be placed locally and in family-based settings.

This strategy seeks to focus on the right solutions and choices to provide children with the best possible outcomes, where accommodation made available always meets the needs of children.

The vision is to:

"Make Wirral great for children, young people and their families"
