NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF JOINT WASTE LOCAL PLAN FOR MERSEYSIDE AND HALTON

The six Councils for Halton, Liverpool, Knowsley, Sefton, St Helens and Wirral have each resolved to formally adopt the Joint Waste Local Plan for Merseyside and Halton which was submitted to the Secretary of State for public examination in February 2012, with effect from 18 July 2013.

The Joint Waste Local Plan has been adopted in line with the recommendations of the Planning Inspector appointed to undertake the public examination, subject to modifications that were published for public consultation in November 2012 and other minor modifications to provide factual updates and correct typographical errors.

A copy of the adopted Joint Waste Local Plan, the Adoption Statement, the Schedules of Modifications, the Inspector's Report, the Sustainability Appraisal Report and a post-adoption Environmental Statement are available for public inspection, free of charge, in the following locations:

Any person aggrieved by the Joint Waste Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. The application to the High Court must be made no later than the end of the period of six weeks starting with the date the Joint Waste Local Plan was adopted.
